# Transfer Agreement Between Dawson Community College and The University of Montana Western's Early Childhood Program, Division of Education

#### **OVERVIEW:**

This formal transfer agreement serves as a memorandum of understanding and is made and entered into by Dawson Community College (DCC) and The University of Montana Western's Early Childhood Program in the Division of Education, herein referred to as the UMW. By this agreement, DCC and the UMW express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access and success in higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures, which assure articulation between programs, the institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transfer from the program of study or associates to a bachelor's degree.

#### **PURPOSE:**

This agreement provides students whose Program of Study prepares them to complete an Associate of Applied Science in Early Childhood Education, at DCC with the option of transferring to complete a Bachelor of Science in Teaching and Learning in Early Childhood or a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education Preschool to Grade Three. Any DCC student who adheres to the guidelines within this agreement is guaranteed that UM Western will accept designated general education credits and early childhood credits to apply such credits to the Bachelor of Science in Teaching and Learning in Early Childhood or Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Education: Pre-Kindergarten to Grade Three in a manner consistent with the treatment of native UM Western students.

#### CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

#### Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

DCC students maintaining continuous enrollment under this agreement will be afforded the same treatment and protection as native UM Western students enrolled under a specific catalog.

Criteria for acceptance into UM Western will be the same for transfer as for native students.

DCC, upon written request of students, will provide verification of completed courses to UM Western through its Office of Admissions and Records. The transcript of students transferring from HC will be evaluated by the Registrar's Office at UM Western.

Transfer students from DCC will have access to UM Western financial aid, scholarships, and student services on the same basis as native students.

Minimum grade of "B-" in Education course work and "C" in all general education courses must be maintained to qualify for transfer under this articulation agreement.

UM Western will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to DCC transfer students as those applicable to native students at UM Western.

#### Section II: Transfer of Credit

A maximum of 27 credit hours will be accepted by UM Western from DCC to be applied to the Associate of Applied Science in Early Childhood Education\*.

A maximum of 72 credit hours will be accepted from DCC to be applied to the Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Education Pre-K to Third Grade or the Bachelor of Science Teaching and Learning in Early Childhood.

#### TERMS of AGREEMENT:

This agreement is made and entered into in the years 2021-2022 and remains in force unless changed in writing by mutual agreement to both parties. The agreement may be amended at any time with the approval of both parties and is subject to regular review to assure currency with the respective degree requirements. Should either party desire to discontinue this agreement, one-year advance notification will be required.

#### SIGNATURES:

Dawson Community College and The University of Montana Western hereby enter into this transfer agreement leading from an Associate of Applied Science in Early Childhood Education to Bachelor of Science in Teaching and Learning in Early Childhood or Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Education: Pre-Kindergarten to Grade Three by the affixing of signatures of the chief executive officers of both institutions.
