The title of Emerita/Emeritus is a unique and special honor. The President and Board of Trustees reserve the title for a select few (no more than three) individuals each year and it is the Board's expectation that only the most outstanding faculty or administrators will be recommended for this unique honor. Emerita/Emeritus status is granted to retiring, full-time faculty and administrators in recognition of dedicated service to the College. It is an earned rank and as such entitles its holders to commensurate rights and privileges.

The Dawson Community College (DCC) President shall nominate to the DCC Board of Trustees the final candidate(s) after all applicants have been received and reviewed by the screening committee. The Board of Trustees may bestow recognition of Emerita/Emeritus Status to retired, full-time faculty and administrators for their distinguished service to the College.
