Western Undergraduate Exchange Memorandum of Agreement

RESPONSIBLE DEPARTMENT: Student Success

The College President is required to implement a College Procedure establishing residency status at the time of admission to the College.

Dawson Community College students will be classified into one of the following residency statuses:

- (1) In-District,
- (2) Out-of-District/In-State,
- (3) Grow Eastern Montana,
- (4) Western University Exchange
- (5) Out-of-State.
- I. Determining In-State vs. Out-of-State status: All students of DCC shall be classified as either Out-of-State or In-State in compliance with Board of Regents Policy 940.1.
- II. Determining In-District vs. Out-of-District status: All admission materials of a student shall be evaluated to determine In-District/Out-of-District status.
 - A student shall be classified as In-District if at least one of the following criteria
 are met: The student owns and pays taxes on real estate property located within
 the Dawson Community College district, or is a dependent of an individual who
 owns and pays taxes on real estate property located within the Dawson
 Community College district; or
 - 2. The student can verify *Domicile* within the Dawson Community College district.
- III. Determining Grow Eastern Montana (GEM) status: Students from North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, and Saskatchewan, CA, shall have their materials evaluated to determine if they may be classified under GEM status.
- IV. Determining Western University Exchange status: Students classified as Out-of-State shall have their materials evaluated to determine if they may be classified under WUE status
- V. Determining Canadian Exchange Rate Status: Students who reside in the bordering Canadian Provinces of Alberta and British Columbia, will be given the rate equivalent to as WUE.

VI. Determining Veterans status: Veterans benefits recipients shall have their admission materials evaluated to determine In-State/Out-of-State status for tuition and fees calculations.

SCOPE This policy applies to Dawson Community College.

The College President shall promulgate such procedures as may be needed to implement this policy. **PROCEDURES**
