

GATEWAY COWBELLE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. This scholarship shall be awarded to a full time student from Dawson County attending any college who is an incoming sophomore. Preference will be given to a student pursuing a degree beneficial to the livestock industry.
2. This one-year scholarship shall be in the amount of \$500 to be paid in two installments of \$250 for each semester. Before money is disbursed by the treasurer, proof of enrollment must be presented to the Gateway CowBelles treasurer.
3. If the student does not complete each semester of school, the scholarship must be paid back for the incomplete semester.
4. The student to receive this scholarship must have and maintain a 2.00 GPA.
