Submission Requirements

- Artist biography
- Artist statement
- Digital images for reproduction (.jpg format)
- Written description of work including title, medium, dimensions, weight (if sculpture)

Selection Process

All entries will be accepted, space allowing. Space constraints may limit artists to one piece, but multiple submissions are welcome. Artists submitting multiple pieces should indicate their preference for the exhibition. Artists will be notified of their selection by February 22, 2019.

Exhibition Opening

The exhibition opening will be held on Monday, March 25, 2019 in the Dawson Community College Gallery. The opening will include a wine and hors d'oeuvre reception and a short talk by at least one of the artists. Artists interested in speaking at the opening should contact the curator.
