Fifteen (15) or Thirty (30) Hour Gambling Addiction Workshop

These intensive workshops are for Licensed Addiction Counselors (LAC) and LAC candidates who need the Gambling and Gaming Addiction Assessment and Treatment for the new LAC licensing requirements. Already licensed LACs may take this introductory class or the advanced class for continuing education (CE) requirements.

This workshop covers neurology, biochemistry, and behavioral components of gambling and gaming addiction in teens, adults, males, and females. At its core is both Assessment and Treatment strategies. The workshop content is relevant to all development of addiction and treatment approaches. A written response will be required from all students.

The workshop is taught by Pete Bruno, who has recently completed a graduate level certificate and has counseled a variety of addictive behaviors in Montana since 1973, including at the inpatient multi-addictions facility at Galen Hospital. Pete Bruno provides a wide range of information for counselors wanting or needing to add this component to their skill set.
