

Longtime DCC Faculty Member Retires

Longtime Dawson Community College faculty member Holly Dershem-Bruce retired following the 2018-2019 academic year. Dershem-Bruce, Criminal Justice faculty and program director, served DCC for 28 years.

Dershem-Bruce has been only the second director of the Criminal Justice Law Enforcement Program, having been at the helm for the last 25 years. She graduated from the program in 1986 and since returning as faculty and program director, has had the opportunity to serve in various faculty leadership roles, including department chair, division director, and as Interim Chief Academic Officer.

"I will definitely miss being a part of the College and being a part of so many student's lives," Dershem-Bruce said. "The last 28 years have not only allowed me to influence a lot of students over that time, but I've also had the opportunity to teach some of their children more recently. With all of our program graduates, as well as those that have gone through our Reserve Officer Training course – the first of its kind developed at a college in Montana – I know that law enforcement and criminal justice are in good hands within our state."

Dershem-Bruce's retirement plans include continuing to teach and develop courses for online programs. She'd also like to eventually find other work in the criminal justice system or a related area.
